### *Ice Breaker – Brainstorm Fundraiser Activity*

- Group #1:
  - **Crazy Kompetition in the MUD**
    - Includes relays and tug of war (in the mud)
    - Small prizes are awarded for winning contests
    - Similar event held for Reality Changers → ask Cami Tam, Angela Yen, or Kelly Fierro
  - **Stop the Beat (or Yank the Crank)**
    - Play an annoying song continuously on Library Walk
    - Set a fundraising quota (i.e. \$100)
    - Have people pay money to reach that quota and stop the song
- Group #2:
  - **Fundraising Carnival**
    - Featuring special guest Lady Gaga
    - Includes raffle for trip to the moon, chocolate slip-n-slide, and Drew-kissing booth ♥
- Group #3
  - Finals De-Stress → have people pay money to **smash a car** to de-stress during finals week
- Group #4
  - Jell-O Pool / **Jell-O Party!** → swim/drown in Jell-O and hold Jell-O eating contest

### *Internal Fundraising Business*

- **Eat for Service @ UCSD**

- How does it work? → restaurant donates a set percentage of each purchase bought with an event flyer and proceeds go towards the hosting organizations
- Tapioca Express (15%); Jamba Juice; Panda Express (20%)
- Tip → choose places where it costs more money to purchase food
- (\*Note: Kelly Chinh, please show Chelsea Li how to do taxes!)
- **Vendor Fair**
  - **Food ideas:** shaved ice, spam musubi, pizookies (problem = melting ice cream), crepes
- **Korean BBQ Tacos**
  - Have another member chair event, because Chelsea doesn't want to be around the tacos =]
- End-of-the-Year Banquet – May 15th
  - **Song dedications** → members pay to dedicate/request a certain song to someone
    - Play along with slideshow
  - Sell **chocolate roses** → raffle ticket given for each purchase
    - Raffle off a dance with a board member or ex-board member (like last year)
  - **Date Auction** (20-minute limit)
    - Auction off 5 people (mostly seniors) → ask for participant permission first
    - Similar to a beauty pageant
    - Have all dates fill out a personality application (i.e. ideal date, birthday, zodiac sign)
  - Other Ideas
    - Big/little sib appreciation → **thank you cupcakes/grams** like New Member Install
    - Sell items that are senior-oriented (i.e. **thank you/goodbye cards; graduation stuff**)
  - Biggest problem → banquet time restrictions; activities too time-consuming
    - ∴ Cut down number/time of activities

### *External Fundraising Business*

- **Waking Up in Vegas (Casino Night)**
  - Concerns → cost of renting casino materials (i.e. renting tables and chips)
  - Masquerade Ball casino equipment rental fee = \$700
  - Possibility → purchase green felt with poker/blackjack on it (like at DCON)
  - Prizes → ask Sears (talk to Jezli Hsueh)
  - Talk to UCI (Jimmy Hung & president-elect), since they hold a poker tournament every quarter
- UCI “All in for UNICEF”
  - \$20 per person (\$10 shirt, \$10 buy-in, food for entire night)
  - Chips given to each participant to play poker
  - Raffle off prizes → Prizes for 1st (Nintendo DS), 2nd (iPod?), 3rd
  - Kiwanians/volunteers were dealers
- Alternate idea → **sell Monster energy drinks** during finals week; have people **pay \$5 to smash a car** with baseball bat
  - Make location reservations → Muir field
  - **Event Name** (Stefanie Chow comes up with weird, random things): SUPER SMASH MONSTERS
  - **Charity:** UNICEF
  - **Audience:** UCSD students
  - **Note:** Jezli has a crowbar o\_\_o
  - Other ideas → burn books in bonfire; dance workshop; garage sale (selling furniture)
  - Jezli has connections to get free Monster energy drinks for a small-scale event
